

DENNE PARK - HOUSE AND ESTATE

The original Jacobean house was built in 1605 and the north-east tower which remains from that time bears this date.

The Eversfield family were major land owners in Southwater, owning land as far south as the area now called Station Road. The house was greatly enlarged to the south and west about 1870 in a matching style and the present west front dates wholly from that time.

The estate was broken up for sale in 1929 and 1930.
