

KINGS FARM, Kings Lane

Kings Farm dates from the 17th century or earlier. It is an L-shaped building and has a massive stone chimney breast at each end. In 1840 it was owned by James Eversfield and occupied by Daniel Chantler.

"Rev W Allis-Smith improved the barn at Kings Farm and it was commissioned as a private chapel for communion services on a monthly basis.

In December 1935 he held three Lantern Services on Sunday evenings."
