

## JACKRELLS FARM, Polecat Lane

This Grade II listed building is dated to the 17<sup>th</sup> century or earlier. In 1755 the farm was owned by William Markwick of Denne Park and occupied by Joan Coates. In 1840 William Smart lived there and in 1881 it was occupied by William Short. It remained as part of the Denne Estate until 1930, when the estate was broken up and sold.

In 1649 John Cowper's wife from Jackrells was buried in Horsham, having died from the plague
