

## BAX CASTLE, Two Mile Ash

This was a beerhouse owned in 1844 by Susannah Bax. Local folk know it as the "Donkey", and the nearby railway bridge is known as "Donkey Bridge"

Henry Smith tells us:

*"Bax, of Two-Mile-Ash, lived in his own cottage, and was a weaver of what was called 'home spun linen' as well as wool."*
