

## LANAWAYS FARM, Two Mile Ash

This timber-framed house has the date 1689 carved into a tie on the front range, and it has been suggested that the rear range is all that remains of a mediaeval hall house. The name 'Lanaway' appears in the Itchingfield parish registers in 1761.

By 1785 the house was owned by Mersons Bayley Ramsden and occupied by William Sharpe. In 1840 it was owned by Robert Henry Hurst and occupied by George Hills. Thomas Ducking (Duckering) held 99 acres in 1881 which had passed to Frederick Fleming by 1912.
