

ELM COTTAGES, Worthing Road

Built by Robert Piper in 1885. The left of the pair of cottages has been used for various purposes over the years.

In 1885 it was a butcher's shop run by J Francis (see BUTCHERS). Jack Oulds ran his coal merchant's business from there in the 1930s, and later it became a confectionery store run by Mrs Burchell.

In December 1977 Belfry Bargains opened its doors there as Southwater's Charity shop (See BELFRY BARGAINS), and now it is a beauty parlour.
