A survey by the Oxford Dendrochronology Laboratory commissioned by Joan Francis of SLHG has dated the construction of this high quality timber-framed house to 1480.

In 1556 the Horsham Parish registers show Agnes Parthing and Joan, wife of Thomas Sayers, as godmothers to Agnes Fuller. In 1785 the house was owned by Sir Henry Fletcher and occupied by George Dawson. In 1805 George Dawson paid £ 59 5s 0d rent and £ 11 17s 0d tax. In 1840 it was occupied by Henry
