

PILFOLDS, Two Mile Ash



This house, a rebuild of an older house named Holbrooks, was demolished in the 1960s to make way for the Horsham bypass.

The 1524 Subsidy Rolls (the list of tax payers in the district) record John Pylfold paying £ 20, William Pylfold £ 3 and Thomas Pylfold £ 20 in Marleposte. In 1840 the house was owned by Robert Hurst and occupied by Robert Rowland.
