

SLUTTS COTTAGE, Two Mile Ash Road

This three-bay hall house lies on the east side of Marlpost/Two-Mile Ash road. It is an early mediaeval house with later additions and alterations.

Documents relating to Marlpost mention a William atte Slutte in 1285. By 1513 'Malhams also Slutts' appears among the possessions of Henry Michell of Itchingfield, who died that year. Slutts most probably formed part of the Lintott estates.

The cottage is now known as Field End.
