

SAYERS FARM, Two Mile Ash Road



The house is a 15th century mediaeval hall house which still retains an intact post-and-plank oak screen.

In the 1524 Subsidy Rolls (list of tax payers) recorded that Thomas Sayars was "paying £ 5 at Marleposte". In 1785 the property was owned by John Champion and occupied by Andrew Samuel. In 1844 it was owned by Elizabeth Greenfield and occupied by Philip Postlethwaite.

In 1881 the 40 acres was farmed by *George Garton*. *AV Cooms*, farmers and dairymen, were there from the 1930s to 1985: they ran a milk delivery round service to the village. In 1985 the farm was sold by the Fletcher estate.
