

RAYLANDS FARM, Polecat Lane,

The 1844 Tithe Map documents show the farm as being owned by George Sayers and occupied by the Misses Sayers. In 1881 it was occupied by Jesse Lewry. At some time the old house was demolished and a replacement built. The property was offered for sale by the Denne Estate in 1930 and purchased by Mr Polley. Post war it was run as a poultry farm by Mr Blackwell, who subsequently used the land to establish a mobile home park.
