

SOUTHWATER SCHOOL

The 1905 school was demolished in 1969 and a modern replacement built on a site just behind the previous building. In 1982 it became the "Southwater County Primary School", with 310 pupils on its roll.



An Infants' School was built on an adjacent site in the 1980s



CASTLEWOOD SCHOOL

To meet the needs of the rapidly increasing population, a third school was built in 1997 to accommodate both infants and juniors. It took its name from the nearby wood.
