

## WOODMAN'S ARMS, Worthing Road

This property, known for many years as Ivydene (now known as Woodman's Hall), was originally a beer house. It was opened on 16<sup>th</sup> March 1865 and according to Henry Smith, "no-one signed in favour of it".

Around 1900 the directories show it was run by Ernest Standen and his family. It was in an ideal place to cater for the men in the brickyard.

A Cherry Fair was held here in 1906.
