The cottage was built in 1935 for Charlie Rhoades when he retired as manager of the brickworks. It had a shop at the back, facing the brickyard road (which originally ran along the northern side of the cottage) selling tobacco and other goods for the brickyard workers.

It is said that the cottage was designed to show many of the special bricks made in the yard.

It was demolished in the 1980s and the replacement offices were built in a similar style.
